


CAWARDEN SOLAR FARM WHAT YOU WILL SEE

An important piece of work that informs our planning proposal is the Landscape and Visual Impact Assessment (LVIA). Working with the planning team at Lichfield District Council, we identify the properties and the areas that are to be considered by the LVIA. Our Landscape Architect then assesses the impact our project may have.










VP3 - View from public right of way looking West with solar farm superimposed assuming 10 years growth of soft screening






